Alumni Mustard Seed Bursary Award

AIM

The **Alumni Mustard Seed Bursary Award** aims to help needy ex-students of CHR with essential school expenses so as to facilitate his/her progression to society.

QUANTUM OF AWARD

ITE	\$800/ Year
JC/ Centralized Institutes/ Polytechnics	\$1000/Year
Total	\$1800/ Year

An amount of \$5000/year will be budgeted for the above-mentioned award as likely more than one applicant for each category will be awarded.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The applicant must have:
 - a. Good conduct
 - b. Attained top 20% of the latest academic results
 - c. Outstanding performance in CCA
 - d. Community involvement
- The applicant and immediate family members must be Singapore citizens.
- The applicant must be attending Institute of Technical Education (ITE), Junior College (JC), Centralized Institute, Polytechnic or Government tertiary institutions.
- The applicant may fall within the following household income criteria:

Family Size	Gross Monthly Household Income
1 or 2 children	\$ 2,500 or below
3 or more children	\$ 1,800 or below

- Priority would be given to students who are **NOT** in receipt of any other bursaries, scholarships, study grant, School Pocket Money Fund of Hope scheme (Home Ownership Plus Education) from other organizations in the same academic year.
- Applicants in receipt of the MOE Financial Assistance Scheme are eligible to apply for the award.
- The Selection Board appointed by the School Alumni will interview eligible applicants.
- The application for the funding will be reviewed on an annual basis.

Important: Eligibility for application does not guarantee the grant of Alumni Mustard Seed Bursary Award
